General Information:

Follow The Star is an outdoor production depicting 10 scenes from the Life of Christ. Participants are encouraged to be ready for the following:

- Thursday and Friday nights are less crowded than Saturday night, which is always the most crowded.
- Come early to avoid the crowds - Gates open at 6:30 PM
- No Cost to Enter - Bring non-perishable canned goods for the HCCM Food Pantry - monetary donations are also accepted in drop boxes on campus.
- Dress for the weather. Be aware of the temperature, wind and possible precipitation.
- Wear comfortable clothing and shoes as there is a lot of walking.
- Consider wagons and or strollers for small children.
- Comfort Stations (Port-a-Potties) will be available along the way.
- Food Trucks will be onsite if you are hungry
- A First Aid Station is available. Any event staff person will be able to direct you to the station.

Drive-Thru Information:

While walking is the best way to see the production, many choose to drive thru each year.

Coming from the West:

Enter W. Whitestone Blvd. from The light at Bagdad Road. Turn left (East) onto W. Whitestone Blvd. (1431) and move to the far right lane. CPPD Officers will direct you from that point.

Coming from the East:

At Bell Blvd. and W. Whitestone Blvd. (1431) drive West. You will pass the Church which will be on the left. Make a U-turn at Bagdad Road, then move to the far right lane. CPPD Officers will direct you from that point.
